We seek to appoint an ambitious and enthusiastic Graduate Sports Coach with rugby specialism for the academic year 2023-24.


We are looking for someone who is passionate about rugby and sees their future in sport. The applicants should not only have a love for rugby but also a passion for developing people.

Our graduate programme aims to prepare you to be able to run your own sports programme and allow you to gain valuable experience for that next level position. The successful applicant will work alongside our current Director of Rugby, Dr Andrew Hall. You will also be exposed to the latest evidence-informed coaching pedagogy, coach up to 16 hours a week and take charge of your own team. It will be a year of discovery and exploration as you find your own coaching and leadership philosophy.

This role will include a budget for CPD and access to a coach mentor throughout your time at Uppingham; the successful applicant will be expected to take full advantage of this as they continue to learn and grow.

Alongside their coaching responsibilities, the GSC will be expected to play a full part in this seven-day-a-week boarding school. This will include involvement in the School's exceptionally varied co-curricular programme, as well as being attached as a tutor to one of the School's 15 boarding houses. There will also be an expectation to be involved in the operational running of the sports programme.

The salary is £15,341.87 per annum, plus free accommodation for the year and food during term time.

Sport at Uppingham

Our vision for sport at Uppingham is to build a world-leading programme in an environment where all pupils can achieve success in sport, from engagement and participation through to competition and performance. We encourage every pupil to take part in and enjoy the many sports on offer, catering for all abilities and talents. We believe that encouraging pupils to understand that personal fitness is essential as part of a healthy lifestyle is an important aspect of the education they receive at Uppingham.

All pupils take part in three sessions of sport each week, including a whole-school programme of games fixtures and other sports on Saturday afternoons. The Graduate Sports Coach will have the opportunity to coach up to 20 hours a week, creating the perfect environment for accelerated learning. The successful candidate will coach across a variety of sports and across all age groups.

The School has a superb Sports Centre, and an enviable number of playing fields, covering some 65 acres. Dependent on the season these grounds can accommodate many different sports. In the autumn term, for example, you would see nine rugby, five hockey and two lacrosse pitches in use. There are also three Astroturf hockey/tennis surfaces, plus Savannah and hard court tennis courts, netball courts, fives courts, a shooting range, climbing wall and an historic 1st XI cricket pitch.
